



JOB ADVERT (PrEP Nurse Tracker): 1 POSITION

The Infectious Diseases Research Collaboration (IDRC) seeks to hire 1 suitable candidate for the SEARCH Phase II project to be based in **Eastern Uganda field site**. The Successful candidates will be reporting to the **Project Coordinator**.

Justification for the position: The PrEP Nurse Tracker will perform the following roles:

1. Oversee the linkage of study participants to the health Centre.
2. Prepare a list of clients who have missed clinic appointments.
3. Make home follow-ups of clients who have not come for their clinic appointments
4. Counsel clients on adhering to their drugs and clinic appointments
5. Provide back up to the study staff.
6. Counsel clients and families on Antiretroviral therapy adherence
7. Follow up on clients who are very weak for support
8. Make reports on clients followed up and the out come
9. Take history on circumstances that precede the death of clients.
10. Triage study participants.
11. Write activity reports.
12. Attend to clients as a clinical services team member.
13. Will be responsible for tracking KPT participants with positive PTB results and HIV exposed infants to receive EID results.
14. Responsible for recruitment and follow up of PrEP participants within the communities

Qualifications and Job specifications

1. A Diploma in General/Comprehensive Nursing from a recognized institution.
2. A Bachelor's degree in nursing is an added advantage.
3. 2 years' experience in HIV counselling, treatment, care, prevention and guidance
4. Experience in HIV related research and community work
5. Must be registered with the Uganda Nurses and Midwives Council with a valid practicing license
6. Excellent team work skills
7. Excellent communication skills (both oral and written)
8. Must be dynamic, self-motivated, demonstrate high initiative and be persuasive.
9. Working knowledge of MS office applications
10. Ability to work in a rural setting when required.
11. Must fluently speak and understand Lusoga, Japadhola, Ateso or Lugwere languages.
